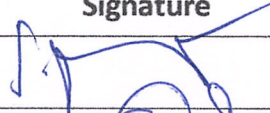
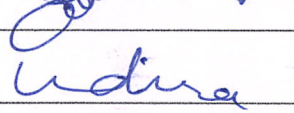
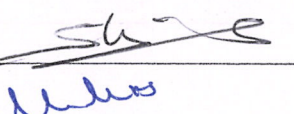
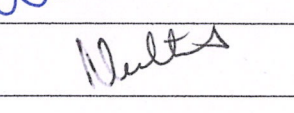
ANTI-RAGGING WEEK – AWARENESS PROGRAMME

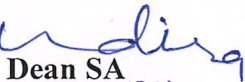

The program was attended by students, faculty members, and members of the Anti-Ragging Committee

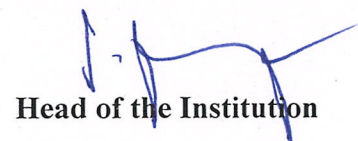
Conclusion
