At the outset, Dr. Y.M. Shashidhara, Coordinator of the IQAC, welcomed all members to the meeting. He presented a comprehensive overview of the activities undertaken by the IQAC office from July 2024 to date. The presentation highlighted the successful completion of various assignments entrusted to the IQAC office, including:

- Conduction of internal and external academic and administrative audits for the year 2023-24
- Participation in professional college ranking processes
- Implementation of quality benchmark initiatives

The coordinator also informed the members about the submission of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for the academic year 2023–24 to NAAC.

Additionally, he outlined the quality benchmarks set for the academic year 2025–26, aligning with the institution's ongoing commitment to academic excellence and continuous improvement.

The following deliberations are also made by the members in the meeting.

- Dr. Basavaraju Manu, Professor at NITK, Surathkal, emphasized the importance of professional bodies in enhancing student development. He encouraged students to actively participate in co-curricular activities, especially cultural events, as a means to build confidence and holistic skills. Additionally, he recommended organizing classes or workshops to support students preparing for competitive examinations such as GATE and UPSC, to better equip them for future academic and career pursuits.
- Mr. Srinivas Ramanujan, highlighted that the IQAC meeting are to be conducted at least quarterly so that the improvements in the academic issues might be monitored and be suggested.
- Mr. K.S. Ravikumar suggested actively involving students in research and development activities to enhance their technical exposure and innovative capabilities. He emphasized the importance of encouraging students to publish patents based on their project work, which would not only enrich their academic profiles but also contribute to the institution's intellectual capital. Furthermore, he recommended promoting green and renewable energy-based projects among students to foster awareness and commitment towards sustainability and environmental responsibility.
- Members suggested to have MOUs with other institutions to achieve more number of inter institution publications/collaborations and have requested to provide seed money to the potential researchers and it may be processed through IQAC
- Dr.J.Chandrika, HoD of CS&E has requested the sufficient infrastructure for conduction
  of classes in their department. She also suggested to create standard formats for various
  activities in the institution.
- Dr. Indira Bahaddur, Associate Dean-Student affairs, has suggested to reform policies on mentoring, feedback, scholarships, green initiatives etc., at the institution level and has requested to fund for hardware projects being carried out by the department students.
- Dr. Prasanna A.A. Dean (Exams) has assured to conduct the audit of examinations department regularly and to submit the annual report.

- Smt. Kumuda H.R. Incharge Registrar and Sri. Manjunath B.N. Department of IS&E have requested to conduct the more training programs for administrative staff of the college.
- Dr. B. Ramesh, HoD, CSBS, has expressed with remarks that the IQAC of the institute is working according to the guidelines of UGC /NAAC and updating all the documents regularly.
- It is proposed to earmark of Rupees 60 lakhs for conducting all the activities / programmes across all the departments for the academic year 2025-26
- Dr. Pradeep S. Director of MCE has suggested to conduct all the programs through IQAC and also all the documents are to be processed through IQAC. Also, he insisted to strengthen the IQAC office for quality outcome in all the respects. Further, suggested to fund for research and development activities of various departments of the institution.
- Dr.A.J.Krishnaiah, Chairperson, IQAC, finally concluded the meeting and appreciated all the members participation in the deliberations of the meeting and also appreciated the efforts made by the IQAC office towards achieving academic excellence and thanked all the members.
