Summary of Stakeholder Feedback

The feedback from stakeholders suggests the need to include more skill development courses. The Employer feedback suggests to include more courses that can improve student's skills in handling modern tools. A few employers pointed out the need to add programming courses for programmes like Civil Engineering and Mechanical Engineering. Teacher feedback indicates that the curriculum should be more correlated with the syllabus of competitive examinations. Student feedback implies that the open elective courses introduced in 2019 enables the student to have more knowledge in multidisciplinary areas. This was one shortcoming concluded from alumnus graduated from the institution in the previous years. All stakeholder feedback suggested to improve the placement opportunities.
