Household survey - Gopanahalli - 08-01-2019

The household survey was conducted by a team of students and faculty members along with Dr. Geetha Kiran A (Coordinator, UBA) from Malnad College of Engineering, as part of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan program at Gopanahalli. The objective of the survey was to identify the key areas of concern and opportunities for development in the village of Gopanahalli and to recommend strategies for addressing them.

A survey questionnaire provided by UBA was used that covered various aspects of household and village development, including education, health, sanitation, agriculture, infrastructure, and social welfare. The questionnaire was administered to each household in the selected villages by the survey team. Around 88 households were surveyed in the village of Gopanahalli. The survey data was collected and compiled using appropriate software and tools, and uploaded to the UBA portal.

Recommendations:

Improve educational infrastructure by setting up more schools and libraries and providing quality education. Enhance access to basic healthcare facilities by setting up mobile health clinics. Boost agricultural productivity by providing irrigation facilities, quality seeds, and market linkages. Simplify the process of accessing social welfare schemes and promote awareness about entitlements among eligible households.

The household village survey conducted for Gopanahalli under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan has provided valuable insights into the key areas of concern and opportunities for development in the villages. The survey findings and recommendations can be used as a roadmap for promoting inclusive and sustainable development in the villages, in partnership with the local community and government authorities.
